

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 6, 1974 at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Present: Ike Fulks, Jim Humphreys, George Hunnicutt

Also Present: Milas Franks, City Manager & Montie Meeks, Attorney

Absent: W.F. McElroy & Roy Roberts

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. D.B. Hollyfield, Jr., Adm. Ass't Wise Co. & City of Norton Health Dept. appeared before council requesting an additional appropriation in the Health Dept. budget for the year 1974-75 due to erroneous percentage 6621 given to Wise County upon which the budget is based.

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by George Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved to honor the request of Mr. Hollyfield in the amount of \$858, said amount to be taken from contingency.

Mr. Elmer Bates, Chairman of Wise Recreational Committee, appeared before council requesting the City to sell the Town of Wise Recreational Committee 141,000 to 145,000 gallons of water for filling Wise Swimming 6622 Pool.

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the City of Norton furnish the Town of Wise Recreational Committee with 141,000 to 145,000 gallons of water at a cost of 75¢/M.

Mr. Bruce Robinette of Lenowisco presented proposed change in ordinance creating an Industrial Development Authority for the Counties of Wise-Lee-Scott and the City of Norton. 6623

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that this proposed ordinance be turned over to the City Attorney for expediting as soon as possible. 6624

Mr. Bruce Robinette, at request of Councilman Hunnicutt, brought council up-to-date on Flood Control for Bear Creek section 6625

Mrs. James Hamilton of 614 Shawnee Avenue appeared before council and expressed her appreciation to council for their help in getting TV Cable Service to her home. She stated she especially wished to thank Mayor Fulks for his help. 6626

Mrs. Hamilton said she would like the weeds cut near the bridge so they can see when driving in or out from their property. The City Manager advised that this work was scheduled for this week.

Attorney Meeks gave report on findings regarding Parking on Oak Avenue. Council discussed this matter after which the City Manager was directed to make a survey of other streets that might be effected and take care of the matter. 6627

The City Manager advised council that the Workable Program had been recertified for another two-year period. He also expressed his appreciation for work Lenowisco did in helping bring about this re-certification. 6628

Mr. Franks reported on the incinerator study being made. 6629

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by George Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following resolution regarding Emergency Water to the Town of Wise was passed: (Page 127) 6630

Councilman Hunnicutt spoke on advisability of giving the City Manager authority to go ahead and expedite this matter as soon as possible. 6631


On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the City Manager be authorized to negotiate this matter with the Town of Wise for the benefit of everyone concerned. 6632

The City Manager advised that the Board of Supervisors of Wise County had favorably considered a resolution in support of City of Norton's desire to annex certain county territory. 6633

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the City Manager move with haste in negotiating with an attorney and consulting engineers regarding the matter of annexing. 6634

On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the ban on extension of water and sewer which presently is restricted on city lines be removed and matter turned over to the City Manager for proper handling. 6635

There being no further business to come before the council same adjourned.
