

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 5, 1973 at 7 30 P.M. with Mayor Fulks presiding.

Present Ike Fulks, Jim Humphreys, Robert Leonard, W.F. McElroy, Roy Roberts

Also Present Montie Meeks, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Edwards, representing Mr. & Mrs. John Leho, Sr. appeared before council requesting that the City develop that portion of 8th Street which had been ~~denied~~ by the City. She also requested the City clean off the street in question. She asked that sewer and water be extended to her lot. Council advised Mrs. Edwards 6320 they would refer the cleaning of the street to the City Manager. Mayor Fulks advised he did not know what could be done regarding developing of street.

Mr. Bill Farmer appeared before council regarding Pedestrians right of way at "Red" lights. He also inquired as to reason drivers of automobiles used second lane coming off viaduct. He also spoke of meter vehicle whizzing around the 6321 corners at "red" light.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the following ordinance setting water & Sewer Connection charges be passed on second reading (Page 64) 6322

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved to adopt on second reading the following ordinance 6323 setting water & sewer rates. (Page 64)

Mr. Jerry Smith of Thompson & Litton presented and reviewed with Council the completed plans & specifications for the Flag Rock Recreation Area Project.

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council authorized the City Manager & firm of Thompson & Litton to advertise for bids on Flag Rock Recreation Area Project. 6324

Mr. Jim Vickers & Mr. Bruce Robinette presented Council with City of Norton Solid Waste Alternatives proposal. Council discussed this matter briefly after which they advised Mr. Vickers & Mr. Robinette that the City Manager would meet with them to go over this matter. 6325

On motion by Jim Humphreys, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that Hearing on Budget for Ensuing year of 1973-74 be advertised to be held on June 14, 1973 at 7:30 P.M. in the Municipal Court Room. 6326

By report the city manager advised council of the opening of the swimming pool. 6327

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the City Manager be authorized to purchase a 6328 10,000 gallon gas storage tank, said expenditure to be taken from Contingency Fund.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the Virginia Horne be appointed as member of 6329 Wise County Regional Library Board for a period of four years, said term to expire June 30, 1977.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous vote council moved that John Litton be reappointed as member of City of Norton School Board for a three year term, said term to expire June 30, 1976. 6330

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Mr. W.H. Witt, Jr. be recommended to Judge for reappointment as member of City of Norton Board of Zoning Appeals for a five year term, said term to expire June 2, 1978. 6331

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Robert Leonard and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Eugene Mullins be recommended to Judge for appointment to Board of Zoning Appeals to fill the unexpired term of Roy Roberts, said term to expire June 2, 1975. 6332

Council tabled the Guest River Water Line Project until it could be reviewed with Board of Supervisors. 6333

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by the following votes council authorized the Mayor & Clerk of Council to execute water contract with C.W. Johnson Construction Company for C. & P. Telephone Co. Project: Ike Fultz, Robert Leonard, W.F. McElroy, Jim Humphreys - Yeah - Roy Roberts abstained from voting. 6334

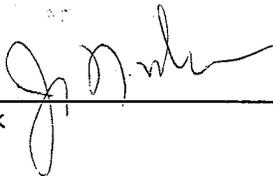

Council discussed request for additional 1972-73 expenditures. No action needed. 6336

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Jim Humphreys and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the City Manager be authorized to publish a planned report of the Revenue Sharing Funds for the entitlement period beginning January 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1973. 6337

Mayor Fultz asked Mr. Meeks, Attorney if he had any information on the tearing down of Old Lay Hardware Building on 5th Street. Mr. Meeks advised he would have necessary information by next council meeting. 6338

There being no further business to come before the Council same adjourned.
