

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room at 7:30 p.m. on June 20, 1972 with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V. O. Flanary, Robert Leonard, Ike Fultz, Archie Woods, W. F. McElroy

Also Present: Milas D. Franks, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. J. T. Caruso appeared before Council reporting there were no stop signs to slow traffic at Little League Field or Pool. He requested that some be placed there. He advised of meeting he had attended with Little League representatives of county at which a member of the Board of Supervisors was present advising that county would be participating in Little League county ball. Mr. Caruso requested that the City look into this matter to see if City of Norton could secure any help on the City's Little League. Mr. Caruso also asked when they were going to start working again on new Little League Field. The above matters were referred to City Manager.

Mrs. Harold McArthur inquired as to when they were going to get street light at 14th Street in Ramsey Section.

Mr. Bob Kilgore asked what progress is being made regarding Norton Machine Works Building. He was advised that due notice had been served on proper parties and that the period of time was not up yet. He stated that if something was not done in near future he planned to get an injunction himself.

The Mayor announced that there was two vacancies on City of Norton School Board. He asked for nomination to fill vacancy of three year term, said term to expire June 30, 1975.

On motion by Robert Leonard, Mr. W. P. Kanto was nominated for reappointment on City of Norton School Board. There being no other nominations W. F. McElroy moved that the nominations be closed.

The Mayor called for a vote with the following results:

The Mayor called for nominations to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Bill Humphrey, resigned, said term to expire June 30, 1974. Mr. Ike Fultz nominated Sue Kuczko - Mr. W. F. McElroy nominated Don Pippin. Councilman Leonard moved that nominations be closed.

The Mayor then called for a vote on Sue Kuczko with the following results: Ike Fultz - Archie Woods, Yes; W. F. McElroy, Robert Leonard, V. O. Flanary, No.

The Mayor then called for a vote on Don Pippin with following results: W. F. McElroy, V. O. Flanary, Robert Leonard, -Yes; Ike Fultz, Archie Woods, No.

Mr. Franks reported on number of certified voters as reported by City Registrar, the number being 945 East Ward, 971 West Ward, making total of 1916.

Mr. Franks presented voting machine contract for purchase of ⁴ voting machines for City of Norton.

On motion by Ike Fultz, seconded by Archie Woods, and carried by unanimous roll call vote Council moved that voting machine be purchased for cash price, \$1960.00 said fund to be taken from Capital Reserve #17 Account.

The City Manager announced that as advertised, it was time for public hearing on City of Norton Budget for fiscal year, 1972-73.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous roll call vote the budget for fiscal year, 1972-73, setting tax rate as recommended by City Manager was passed. 6055

Mr. Franks gave a brief report on stocking city reservoir with fish. 6056

On motion by Ike Fultz, seconded by W. F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Roy Roberts be recommended to Judge of Circuit Court for reappointment as member of City of Norton Zoning Board of Appeals for a term of three years said term to expire June 30, 1975. 6057

Council scheduled next regular council meeting for July 6th due to July 4th falling on regular council date. 6058

Councilman Fultz inquired as to when they would receive new paving schedule. 6059

Councilman McElroy asked if lights had ever been synchronized. 6060

The City Manager presented request from Presbyterian Church to Norton Planning Commission for an exchange of 25' of their property for 25' of City street for parking.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote Council moved that exchange of property be made with Presbyterian Church with condition that Presbyterian Church fill in the property conveyed to City and properly grade same to provide sufficient area to accommodate 16 parking spaces the cost of any relocation and restoration to existing street to be borne by the Presbyterian Church said parking area to be constructed to leave a minimum of 30' in width for the free flow of through traffic. 6061

On motion by Robert Leonard seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote Council moved that Mrs. Judy Hughes be appointed as Clerk of the Municipal Court. 6062

On motion by W. F. McElroy, seconded by Ike Fultz and carried by unanimous vote the following resolution regarding dangerous property of Flowers Estate was passed. (Insert Page 122) 6063
