

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room at 4:00 P.M., Friday, August 28th.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard, Robert Leonard

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Manager

Mayor Flanary announced that the first thing on the agenda was Jail Bids. Council discussed the bids with Joel Vicars, Architect.

On motion by Robert Leonard, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous vote council moved that all bids on jail be rejected. 5244

Mr. Norton reported that he had only four men who were willing to serve on the Board of Equalization. Council directed the city manager to come up with at least nine men for them to select a five man board at next council meeting. 5245

Council discussed briefly cost of constructing water & sewer lines in David Ball and Tommy Owens Subdivisions. Council authorized the City Manager to take 5246 note from them for \$480.00 and proceed with construction.

Mr. Norton advised council the city's annual picnic would be Saturday, September 12th. 5247
