

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 20, 1969 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley, W.G. Stallard.

Also Present: Evan Norton, City Mgr. & J. Robert Stump, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Hoge Horne appeared before council requesting that street between 8th Street and Virginia Avenue, known as John Street be closed. Council discussed this matter 4838 at length. The city attorney advised that with the necessary procedures this street could be vacated. He advised Mr. Horne that the proper application should be made to the city manager for closing of this street.

Mr. Vic Jones appeared before council in regard to letter received from City of Wyoming inviting city officials to attend the Rodeo in Wyoming on July 19th. Council agreed to have representation at this Rodeo. Mr. Jones also spoke to council regarding officials from City of Wyoming who were coming to Norton to attend the city's Diamond Jubilee celebration. A committee was appointed for entertainment, etc. of the City 4839 Council from Wyoming with Ab Still, chairman, Cecil Gardner and Vic Jones.

Mr. Norton discussed briefly purchase of keys and plaque for City Officials of 4840 Wyoming.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous roll call vote council authorized the city manager to purchase keys and plaque in an amount not to exceed \$50.00.

Mr. Norton discussed with council float for Diamond Jubilee celebration.

On motion by W.G. Stallard, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous roll call vote council moved that the sum of \$149.50 be appropriated to purchase 4841 decorations for float for City of Norton.

Council requested that committee for entertainment at Diamond Jubilee for City 4842 Officials of Wyoming contact officials of City of Wyoming to find out details of Rodeo.

Timothy Jones inquired of council as to when stop light was going to be installed on 9th Street and Park Avenue and also stop sign at corner of Virginia Avenue, Kline Avenue and Eighth Street. Mr. Norton advised that the sign at corner of Virginia Avenue, Kline and Eighth Street was to be replaced. Mr. Jones also inquired of 4843 Teen Center. Mayor Flanary advised of the committee working on this matter at this time.

Mr. Norton advised council that budget would be advertised on May 29th for 4844 public hearing to be held on June 12th.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote council moved that the Charter for Lenowisco be adopted as recommended by the 4845 City Attorney.

Council discussed bond referendum with different councilmen stating their opinion. Mr. Norton advised that there would be another meeting May 26th at 7:30 P.M. in the 4846 Municipal Building for all civic organizations. Also would be presented to Kiwanis Club on June 3rd at noon meeting, with first public hearing on May 27th.

Mr. Norton discussed briefly with council Workable Program. 4847

On motion by W.G. Stallard, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote council moved that Mr. Charlie Bond be appointed chairman of U.N. Day Committee. 4848

Mr. Norton reported on trip to Richmond for State meeting on Federal Projects.

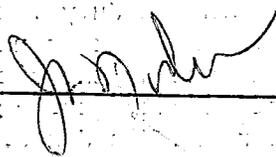
Council discussed briefly new garbage container system.

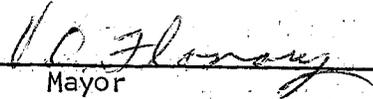
Mayor Flanary advised council that road into camping area at Flag Rock was being worked on.
