Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. ~~Charles~~ <sup>John</sup> Litton appeared before Council and presented proposed plans for track and Little League Field on City Property on Kentucky Avenue. Council discussed this matter at length. No definite action taken. 4852

Mr. Norton brought Council up to date on the bond referendum. 4854

Mr. Norton presented amendments to LENOWISCO Charter. On motion by S. H. Neeley, seconded by G. E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that amendments to LENOWISCO Charter be adopted. 4855

Mr. Norton brought to Council's attention the Public Hearing on the Budget, on June 12th. 4856

Mr. Norton discussed briefly with Council Thoroughfare Plan. Action deferred until next meeting in June. 4857

Mr. Norton advised Council of Christmas decorations. 4858

Mr. Norton discussed with Council proposed playground improvements on Kentucky Avenue to include swimming pool. 4859


