

April 2, 1968

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 2, 1968 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley

Also Present: David Norman, City Manager & Robert Stump & Leslie Mullins, Attorneys.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Carl McAfee, representing J.W. Shupe, appeared before Council respectfully #4353 requesting report of opposition the City has to issuing a beer license to said party, implied by the A B C Officer. After a lengthy discussion, Council advised Mr. McAfee that this matter was to be taken up with the A B C Board.

The City Manager reported on sales tax receipts for School • \$5,062 • Local \$7,772.00 #4354

Mr. Norman discussed with Council an additional pump on Henry Street. After #4355 a discussion of matter, Council instructed the City Manager to check into the possibilities of connecting pump to a tank on hill above Henry Street.

Mr. Norman advised Council of refunds received on Workmen's Compensation. #4356

The Treasurer gave a report on delinquent taxes, including a list of the 1966 #4357 unpaid Real Estate Taxes.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the Treasurer print a list of the delinquent taxes for the year 1966, explaining out that this is only the principle amount for 1966, not including any taxes prior to 1966 nor any penalty and interest nor any items under \$10.00. Also setting forth that it is the Treasurer's intention to pursue the collection of these taxes.

Council discussed briefly operation of swimming pool. Council was in agreement #4358 for the pool to be operated this year.

Use Tax Resolution was tabled until next meeting. #4359

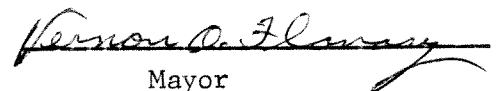
Mayor Flanary advised Council of his recent trip to Elmira regarding fire #4360 truck which will be here last of April or first of May.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous #4361 roll call vote, the following resolution was passed:

Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia that David B. Norman, City Manager, be empowered to negotiate with Wise County National Bank for the purpose of obtaining a loan in the maximum amount for the purchase of new fire truck in view of the many capital expenditures facing the City.
