On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the firm of Greear, Bowen, Mullins and Winston was appointed as City Attorneys.




On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by Bill Stallard, Mr. Monroe Thrower was appointed City Auditor.
