

January 17, 1967

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on January 17, 1967 at 7:00 P. M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Mr. James Vaughn appeared before Council requesting pool room license for Palace Pool Room. #3903

On motion by R.L. Collins, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council granted permission for the issuance of a pool room license to James Vaughn, T/A Palace Pool Room.

Mrs. Myrtle Collier appeared before Council regarding parking situation in front of her property on The Terrace. Matter referred to City Manager. #3904

Attorney Mullins advised Council there was no need for any further action on change in school appropriation. (See Page 38, #3902 of Minute Book) #3905

Mr. Norman advised Council of the status of Kentucky Avenue. #3906

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council granted permission to Mr. Norman to attend Advance Management Training Program in Chicago from March 5th to 10th. #3907

Mr. Norman presented Finance Report for month of December, 1966. #3908

Mr. Frank Bolling appeared before Council requesting permission for pool room license for Sportsman Pool Room. #3909

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council granted permission for the issuance of Pool Room license to Frank Bolling, T/A The Sportsman.

Mr. Norman advised Council that the school superintendent had advised that the school was having problems with pigeons. #3910

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that matter be referred to school board for getting rid of pigeons.

Mayor Flanary brought to Council's attention leaking fire hydrant on Main Avenue S.W. near Steak and Shake Drive-Inn. Matter referred to City Manager. #3911

Mr. Norman advised Council of State Department of Highway Representative Mr. Ripley's visit to Norton regarding East Park Avenue. #3912

Mr. Norman presented Pitometer Leak Survey Report. #3913

Mr. Norman discussed with Council snow removal program. #3914

Mr. Norman advised Council of savings on stone. #3915

Mr. Norman advised Council of daily radio broadcasts of City Government #3916

Mr. Norman advised Council of resignations within the Police Department. #3917

Mr. Norman advised Council of letter received from Mr. Russell of T V Cable Service, regarding change in service. #3918

Mr. Norman advised Council that the City is having a problem again with trash in alley from 6th to 8th Street. #3919

Mayor Flanary inquired as to what disposition had been made of loading #3920 zone in front of Frank's Little Store #1. Mr. Norman advised Council that parking meters were to be installed there.

Attorney Mullins, speaking in behalf of Boy Scouts, brought to #3921 Council's attention the work of the Boy Scouts in cleaning up section around Benges Rock.

Mayor Flanary brought to Council's attention request of church #3922 people concerning parking in area of Methodist and Presbyterian Churches. Mr. Flanary stated that people had complained of wrecked cars taking up parking places in this area.

Councilman Bryant inquired as to some of the problems that will arise #3923 in changing water billing dates.

Miss Yeary and some of her pupils from her Government Class visited #3924 Council.

There being no further business to come before Council, the same adjourned.
