

April 4, 1967

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 4, 1967 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley, Jr.

Also Present: David Norman, City Mgr. & Leslie Mullins, Robert Stump, Attorneys.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Ralph Blevins appeared before Council requesting refund of City license paid for year on business which was sold. Matter tabled. #3980

Walter Freeman of Laurel Avenue appeared before Council regarding large stone in road. He stated that he had ruined two tires and Mr. Greear three. Matter referred to City Manager. #3981

Mr. Ab Still appeared before Council regarding intersection at 10th Street and Park Avenue. The City Attorney advised Council of legal opinion of this matter. The matter of flow of traffic at such intersection referred to City Manager for study. #3982

Charlie Daniels presented to Council report of committee study of water extension to Thacker's Branch. It was the recommendation of the committee that Council take this report under advisement and study. #3983

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the recommendations of the committee be accepted that an executive meeting of City Council be held Wednesday, April 5th at 5 o'clock.

Mr. Norman presented estimated cost of Roberts Avenue sewer extension. #3984

On motion by R.L. Collins, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council instructed the City Manager to proceed with the Roberts Avenue sewer extension.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that City of Norton offer to the New York Mining & Mfg. Co. \$1.00 per acre for approximately 20 acres for such land that is available for garbage dump. Mineral rights to be reserved by New York Mining & Mfg. Co. #3985

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution was passed: #3986

Be It Resolved by the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, that the Judge of the Circuit Court of Wise County, Virginia, is respectfully requested, pursuant to Virginia Code Sections 63-53 and 63-56, to enter an Order re-appointing David B. Norman as one of the Board members of the Norton City Board of Public Welfare, which term of office shall be retroactive to November 21, 1966, and which term of office shall expire on the 21st day of November, 1969.

Councilman Hunnicutt commended the Mayor of the City of Norton for taking it upon himself to build a road to Flagrock. Each member of the Council commended the Mayor in his efforts in this. #3987

The City Manager gave report of sales tax for month of January - \$7,287.97, City's share and \$5,091.39, School Share. #3988

Mr. Norman reported on additional parking spaces between 8th & 9th Street. He stated there were fifteen additional parking spaces. #3989

Mr. Norman gave report of dog control program. #3990

Mr. Norman advised Council of status of Kentucky Avenue. #3991

Mr. Norman reported to Council on his meeting in Richmond on March 24th on Demonstration Cities. He stated that the attitude was very favorable toward the City of Norton. He also advised Council that members of the committee meet in Washington with Federal Officials.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that Mr. Hunnicutt, Mr. Kanto and Mr. Norman attend this meeting in Washington.

Mr. Norman showed slides of the Flag Rock.
