

June 20, 1967

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room at 7:30 P.M., June 20, 1967, with Mayor V.O. Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley, Jr.

Also Present: David Norman, City Manager & Robert Stump, Attorney.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Clayton Booher appeared before Council regarding moving meters from his property and the Carrie Massey property. Matter referred to City Manager. #4057

Mr. Bryan Sargent appeared before Council inquiring as to status of previous request regarding Cowden Street. Council advised Mr. Sargent that this matter would be checked into. #4058

Mr. Charlie Daniels, Chairman of Norton Planning Commission, presented recommendation that Council appoint a committee to discuss with members of the First Baptist Church matter of playground being constructed on Park Avenue on the lot presently owned by the First Baptist Church. Charlie Daniels advised that the Planning Commission feels that this matter should be studied carefully, considering future growth of the City of Norton. #4059

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that a committee be appointed to discuss this matter with members of the First Baptist Church to see what can be worked out.

Mayor Flanary appointed the following as committee: C.W. Bryant, G.E. Hunnicutt, S.H. Neeley, David Norman

Mr. F.B. Kline appeared before Council regarding approach to Middle Norton Land Company's lots in northwest section of Norton. Mr. Kline presented request of either City grading streets or authorizing the Middle Norton Land Company to grade streets according to preliminary plans submitted by Thompson & Litton. #4060

After discussion of this matter and on motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that preliminary plans as presented be approved provided that work is done according to City Code, with exception of 13th Street extended to Adams Street which is approximately 150 feet, which is not feasible to comply strictly by Code.

Councilman Hunnicutt clarified to Attorney Stump the matter of truck terminal being located in the City of Norton. #4061

Attorney Stump presented legal holidays for Council's consideration in regards to parking meter tickets being given. #4062

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that this matter be referred to and discussed with Greater Norton, Inc.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that budget for ensuing year 1967-68 be passed on second reading. #4063

Finance Report for month of May, 1967 was presented and discussed. #4064

On motion made and duly seconded and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the Norton Insurance Company be requested to prepare a statement of City's insurance accounts and submit to Council at next meeting. #4065

Councilman Bryant complimented the work of the new street cleaner. #4066

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that regular Council meeting of July 4th be held July 11th. #4067

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that John Litton be reappointed as member of City of Norton School Board for three year term, said term to expire June 30, 1970. #4068

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that Monroe Thrower be appointed to audit City of Norton books for year ending June 30, 1967, said audit to be presented to Council seventy-five (75) days after fiscal expiration date. #4069

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that S.E. Trinkle be appointed as member of Board of Zoning Appeals and that Harold Hagy, Bill Witt, W.H. Witt, Jr. and N.H. Shell be reappointed for three year terms, said terms to expire June 30, 1970. #4070

Mr. Norman presented City Manager's Report. #4071

Mayor Flanary presented to Council a request of Monroe West and Jack Adams of Craig Street regarding Curb & Gutter. Council discussed this matter in detail. #4072

Council discussed extension of sidewalk on Chestnut Street. The City Manager was instructed to report to next Council meeting regarding this matter. #4073

Mayor Flanary advised Council that Mr. Wharton had inquired as to how soon City would vacate their dump. #4074

The Mayor and City Manager were instructed to contact Cliff Stallard regarding final survey on proposed garbage dump. #4075

Mr. Norman advised Council that the pipe for water line to Thackers Branch extension has not been received. #4076

There being no further business to come before Council, same adjourned.
