

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 5, 1966 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Holcomb presiding.

Present: J.C. Holcomb, Archie Woods, V.O. Flanary, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins

Also Present: David Norman, City Manager & Leslie Mullins, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Carroll Tate spoke briefly to council regarding his editorial on sales tax in a recent issue of the Coalfield Progress. #3599

On motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, John Harman & Cecil Gardner were appointed as members of the Board of Assessors to replace W.F. McElroy and Wm. M. Cooke, resigned. #3600

Mr. Norman presented request of Church of God in Ramsey for curbing in front of their church. He stated they would place the sidewalk if the City would put in the curb & gutter. Council instructed the City Manager to proceed with this project. #3601

A brief discussion of ordinance regarding trailers in City was held. Attorney Mullins briefed Council on the provisions of the code. Council expressed their desire to abide by the Code. #3602

Mr. Norman presented request for street light on Main Avenue between Steak and Shake and Witt Building. #3603

On motion by Archie Woods, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council instructed the City Manager to request installation of street light on Main Ave. between Steak and Shake and Witt Building.


Mr. Norman discussed with Council Highway #58 Project. Mr. Norman advised Council that he had been advised by the State Highway that plans for Highway #58 had been shelved. After a brief discussion Council instructed the City Manager to get in touch with Highway officials in Richmond & make plans to go to Richmond to represent the City before the State Highway Commission. #3604

Mr. Norman advised Council that he would be out of town from Wednesday thru Friday attending the Municipal Management Institute in Georgia. #3605

Mr. Norman advised Council that he had received another letter from George Wharton regarding City trash dump. Mr. Norman stated, that in his opinion, Mr. Wharton's new suggestions were prohibitive. Council stated they would continue with the present lease until July. #3606

Mr. W.P. Kanto appeared before Council and presented school budget of 1966-1967. On motion by Archie Woods, seconded by V.O. Flanary and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the City of Norton School ~~XXXXX~~ Budget as presented be accepted with change made in amount of City's contribution to \$187,000.00. #3607
