On motion by George Hunnicutt, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, David B. Norman was reappointed City Manager for the City of Norton. #3753

On motion by Sam Neeley, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, H.M. Bandy was reappointed as Police Justice for City of Norton. #3754




Upon request of new members of Council, the City Attorney read the duties of City Council and of the City Manager. #3757
