

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Building on September 15, 1966 at 5:00 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.


Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley

A motion was made by George Hunnicutt, seconded by Bob Collins and unanimously passed to adopt an ordinance to close the alley from Craig to Poplar and parallel to Oak, on the condition that the person requesting such closing agrees that should the City incur any expense due to the opposition to said closing that this person 3776 hold the City harmless from any expense.

A motion was made by Bob Collins and seconded by George Hunnicutt that Kentucky Avenue be improved by leveling up the rough sections and by seal coating the entire surface from 11th Street to Highway 74 and that said project stay within the budget. Motion carried unanimously. 3777
