

November 15, 1966

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on November 15, 1966 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins, S.H. Neeley

Also Present: Leslie Mullins, Attorney & David Norman, City Manager

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mrs. Betty Sommers appeared before Council inquiring as to what she could do about her leaves. After a lengthy discussion, Council instructed the City Manager and Fire Chief to look into this matter and see what can be worked out. #3845

Dr. W.H. Hankins appeared before Council requesting that something be done to road leading to his property. After a discussion of this matter and upon recommendation of City Attorney, Council moved that a conference of involved parties be held to determine as to what should be done. #3846

Walter Freeman appeared before Council requesting that something be done to the rough road and water drainage on Laurel Avenue, S.W. Matter referred to City Manager. #3847

Mr. Freeman also spoke in behalf of J.T. Greear regarding City Water extension. Council suggested that an agreement of concerned parties be submitted to the City Manager for consideration. #3848

The City Manager discussed with Council a proposal of raising parking meter fines from 25¢ to 50¢. #3849

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the parking meter fines be left at 25¢.

Mr. Norman read letter from Mr. Douglas Fugate of the State Highway Dept. in answer to Council's resolution request for public hearing on relocation of Route #23. The letter stated there are no hearings scheduled as yet. #3850

In view of the above letter, Council discussed need of immediate attention to ~~XXX~~ Alternate 58 and Route #23 East of Norton. Council instructed the City Manager to take this matter up with the Highway Department. #3851

Mr. Norman advised Council of the status of Kentucky Avenue paving by Pope Construction Company. He stated that Pope Construction Company would be back Wednesday Morning. #3852

Mr. Norman read letter from Mr. Robert Weaver, Secretary, Dept. of Housing & Urban Development, regarding Demonstration Cities Program. Council instructed the City Manager to proceed with this Program. #3853

Discussion of possibility of water being provided to Thackers Branch was held. The Mayor appointed "Red" Trinkle & Harold Armsey to work with City Manager and Cliff Stallard as a study committee regarding this matter. #3854


Mr. Norman presented Treasurer's Report for month of October, 1966. #3855


Mr. Norman advised Council of status of Fire Dept. Due to resignation of one of previously appointed truck drivers, the City Manager appointed Joe Adkins as truck driver. Mr. Norman advised Council of Fire School to be held beginning November 28th with Frank Hubble, State Instructor as Director and Bill Quarterman and Earle Brown as instructors. #3856

Mayor Flanary brought to Council's attention request of Jimmy Cooper #3857 for Chestnut Street extended to be completed. After a lengthy discussion and on motion by C.W. Bryant, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the barricade be removed and some stone be placed from the existing pavement on Chestnut to the intersection of Chestnut and Highland.

Mr. Norman presented audit for year ending June 30, 1966. #3858

There being no further business to come before the Council, same adjourned.
