

December 6, 1966

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on December 6, 1966 with Mayor Flanary presiding.

Present: V.O. Flanary, G.E. Hunnicutt, S.H. Neeley, C.W. Bryant

Absent: R.L. Collins

Also Present: David Norman, City Manager & Robert Stump, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Norman discussed with Council air pollution control. #3859

Mr. Norman advised Council that the Laurel Avenue road had been repaired. #3860

Councilman Bryant inquired as to status of Kentucky Avenue drainage. #3861

Mr. Norman presented request of Telephone Company for permission to install #3862 telephone booths at various locations within the City of Norton for public convenience.

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the Telephone Company be granted permission to install telephone booths at various locations, subject to 10 day removal clause.

Council discussed need for financial committee. #3863

On motion by G.E. Hunnicutt, seconded by S.H. Neeley and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the Mayor appoint a three man Finance Committee to advise Council regarding general finances, budget, etc. of the City.

Mayor Flanary appointed the following as members of the Finance Committee: #3864
W.F. McElroy, M.B. Thrower and David Norman.

Council agreed to have a dinner meeting Monday, Dec. 12th, 6:00 P.M., to #3865 discuss with the Auditor the audit for the year ending June 30, 1966.

Mr. Norman outlined to Council the detailed method of enforcing the Dog #3866 Ordinance.

Mr. Norman discussed briefly with Council the Christmas Decorations. #3867

Mr. Norman advised Council of the current tax collections. #3868

Mayor Flanary advised Council of complaints he had received regarding a #3869 house in Ramsey near Clarence Ramey residence. Matter referred to City Manager.

On motion by S.H. Neeley, seconded by G.E. Hunnicutt and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that beginning with next regular meeting, Council would #3870 meet at 7:00 P.M. through the month of March.

There being no further business to come before the Council, same adjourned.
