On motion by Archie Woods, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote 2 + 6 of those present the following resolution was passed:

WHEREAS, THE City Council of Norton, Virginia, recognizes the need for commercial air service and better transportation facilities to serve Wise County and the City of Norton, Virginia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Norton, Virginia, does support, endorse, and wholehealtedly approve of the action being taken by the Cumberlands Airport Commission to make the necessary improvements to Lonesome Pine Airport to meet the requirements to secure commercial air service.

The City Council and City School Board discussed the budget for the school for ensuing year of 1965-66 after which council gave tentative approval of the city's appropriation of \$172,100.00.
