The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on June 1, 1965 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Holcomb presiding.

The mayor announced that as advertised at this time we will have the public hearing on the proposed budget for 1965-1966. No one appeared to speak. Mr. Jester read the recap of the complete budget.

On motion by V.O. Flanary, seconded by R.L. Collins and carried by unanimous vote the proposed budget for the ensuing year 1965-66 was passed on first reading.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Dewey Stover, appeared before council concerning recreation center behind Ray's Barber Shop. Council advised Mr. Stover that they would give him a definite 2436 answer at next council meeting.

Mr. B ryant reported that Mrs. Hobart Blevins on corner of 5th Street and Roberts Avenue had called and asked that he request a street light on that corner. 2437 She stated she had been robbed Sunday while out and thought it a good idea for a street light.

Mr. Jester advised council of the gasoline bids received as of this date. The bids being as follows: Sinclair 14.75; Texaco 15.55; Esso 15.90. These bids will be effective June 16th thru December 16th.

Mr. Jester gave a report of delinquent taxes for the month of May, 1965 taxes \$680.28; penalty & interest \$212.11 or a total for the month of \$892.39; making a total for the year of \$20,777.82.

Mr. Jester advised council of the bids received on the police car. On motion by V.O. Flanary, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Mr. Jester was authorized to place an order for two plymouth vehicles with Kanto Motors, said company being lowest bidder.
