

A special meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 24, 1965 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Holcomb presiding.

On motion made and duly seconded the following resolution was passed:

Whereas, it has been brought to the attention of the Council of the City of Norton that due to inadvertence the candidates for the following City Offices, Treasurer, 2506 Commissioner of Revenue, City Sergeant and Justice of the Peace, did through inadvertence fail to properly qualify according to Virginia Law in order that their names may be placed upon the official printed ballot for the General Election in November of 1965; and

Whereas, it is the expressed desire and wish of the council of the City of Norton that our representatives namely, Honorable M.M. Long, Honorable Orby L. Cantrell and Honorable Robert Orr endeavor to cause the Charter of the City of Norton amended or a local law passed that would change the method of qualification for the candidates for said election so that the said candidates could become properly qualified to be placed on the ballot.

Therefore, Be It Resolved that the said Council request our said representatives to do all reasonably possible to accomplish this purpose, and that a copy of this resolution be directed to the Honorable M.M. Long, Honorable Orby L. Cantrell and Honorable Robert Orr.

This resolution having been unanimously passed this the 24th day of August, 1965.
