

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on October 19, 1965 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Holcomb presiding.

Present: J.C. Holcomb, Archie Woods, V.O. Flanary, C.W. Bryant, R.L. Collins

Also Present: David B. Norman, City Manager & Leslie Mullins, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. & Mrs. Fred Adams and Mrs. Kedric Adams appeared before council in regard to the Stewart property. They stated that the property had not been put back in as good a condition as before the sewer construction. Council discussed this matter and advised Mrs. Adams that they would check into the matter again and try to see that everything was done as per agreement. Mrs. Adams stated that she did not want to make a hardship on anyone but if the matter was not cleared up satisfactorily she felt they would have to take further action. #3454

Mrs. Adams requested of council a written agreement with the City regarding water connections to Stewart Property as per agreement when water service was placed in the Josephine area. Also she requested sewer connection agreements in writing. Council referred this matter to City Manager.

Mr. Norman gave a report on work that had been done on Stewart Farm. by the City and Daniel's as per Council's instructions. #3455

Mr. R.T. McNeas appeared before Council and requested that something be done to eliminate water holes in gutters along Park Avenue. #3456

Mr. Norman presented Treasurer's Report for month of September, 1965 #3457

Mr. Norman presented an ordinance for annexation of remainder of Whitaker's Farm for Council's consideration. Council discussed this matter at length. Upon suggestion of City Attorney, Council agreed that much more study is required and should be given to this matter regarding requirements of subdivision ordinance. #3458

Mr. Norman presented street light requests of Mrs. Nelle Bolling at back of Bolling Apartment; one at 117-4th Street and one at 1525 Spring Avenue. #3459

Mr. Norman recommended the installation of 2500 lumen light at 1525 Spring Ave.

On motion made and duly seconded and carried by unanimous vote, the City Manager was authorized to have a street light installed at 1525 Spring Avenue. The City Manager was instructed to check again on the street light at Bolling Apts.

Mr. Norman brought to Council's attention the necessity of a salt spreader. Council instructed the City Manager to get quotations from more than one company. #3460

Mr. Norman gave report of revenue received from T V Cable Service for the past two years. Council discussed at length the T V Franchise with the Attorney. #3461

Mr. Norman brought to Council's attention request of Edward's T V Service for a parking space in front of their building. After a brief discussion Council agreed to permit a driveway for entrance to his property. #3462

Mr. Norman advised Council that a 6" water line was being installed on Hagan Avenue between Craig & Poplar Streets. #3463

Mr. Norman discussed briefly with Council the accounts receivable. #3464

Attorney Mullins advised Council that he would fill in for the City until Mr. Winston decided definitely as to whether he was going to leave Norton. #3465


Mr. Holcomb advised Council that Mr. McElroy, chairman of Electoral Board #3466 of City of Norton had requested that salary of judges & clerks of elections be increased to \$20.00.


On motion by Archie Woods, seconded by C.W. Bryant and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the salary of Clerks & Judges at election be increased to \$20.00.

Councilman Bryant brought to Council's attention the difference in size #3467 of sewer line on Chestnut Street. He stated that part of the line was 6" and part 8". He suggested that the line from Hagan to the end of Chestnut Street be changed to 8" line. Council was in agreement with this suggestion and instructed the City Manager to go ahead and change the line from 6" to 8".

Council agreed that since general election falls on regular council meeting #3468 night, Council will meet November 1, 1965 at 7:30 P.M.

There being no further business to come before the Council same adjourned.
