On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous  $\# 2^6 \%$  roll call vote the following resolution was passed:

Be It Resolved that inasmuch as there will be a vacancy in the office of the Commissioner of R venue of the City of Norton caused by the resignation of Mr. H.G. Dalton on account of ill health to be effective March 17, 1964,

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the council of the City of Norton does hereby recommend to the Honorable M.M. Long, Jr., Judge of the Circuit Court of Wise County, Mr. O.V. Willard for appointment to fill the unexpired term of this office.

Mr. Francis of the Bristol-Norton Bus Company appeared before council in regard to moving terminal to Joe Nard Building and lot on Park Av enue. He requested that he be allowed a loading zone, entrance to lot and removal of parking meters in #26% front of building.

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous vote this mateer was left to the City Manager to work out to the best intetests of the City.

There being no further business to come b efore the council same adjourned.
