On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following resolution was passed:

WHEREAS, a total of six (6) bids were received on Parts I and V of the sanitary sewer improvements. Bids were hereby received and tabulated and considered by the Council, City Manager and Hayes, Seay, Mattern & Mattern Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the firm of J. M. Turner and Company and Aaron J. Conner, having submitted the lowest bid, in the sum of \$628,100.00, using vitrified clay pipe, is hereby awarded the contract for Parts I and V, subject to final approval by the Department of Health, Education and Welfare.
