

May 5, 1964

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on May 5, 1964 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, J.C. Holcomb, A.O. Umstead, Archie Woods

Absent: J.B. Taggart

Also Present: C. Franklin Jester, Jr., City Manager & R.T. Winston, City Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Sol Cury appeared before council regarding taxation for the Norton Community Hospital. After a lengthy discussion Mr. Winston, City Attorney, advised Council and Mr. Cury that this matter was to be presented to the court next Tuesday, May 12th. #2730

Mr. Parkis Dotson appeared before Council requesting curb & gutter and sidewalk for his new proposed drive-in restaurant on East Park Avenue. After discussion of drainage problem, it was the opinion of the City Council that a black top surface would be better suited to the situation at this time, to which Mr. Dotson agreed. Mr. Dotson agreed that if the City built the pavement, he would build the sidewalk. #2731

Mr. Jester advised Council that the City had received a second Planning Advance of \$19,200. *for sewer system.* #2732

Mr. Jester presented request of Blood Bank for reimbursement of City sticker. #2733
On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that the City reimburse the Blood Bank \$10.00 for the purchase of a City sticker.

Mr. Jester gave report on delinquent tax collections for the month of April. Taxes = \$846.15; penalty & interest = \$349.22; making a total collected for the year of \$21,053.82. #2734

Mr. Jester presented fire report for the month of April. There were two fire calls during the month. #2735

Mr. Jester advised Council of the following gasoline bids received today: Texaco = 15.9; Sinclair = 16.0; Esso = 16.9 #2736


Mr. Jester presented a petition from the committee of the Powell Valley Evangelistic Crusade requesting permission to hang a banner advertising this crusade from May 25th to June 28th. This matter was referred to the City Manager. #2737

Mr. Winston advised Council that Mr. J.M. Yeary's term on the electoral board had expired. #2738

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by Archie Woods and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that it be recommended to the Circuit Judge that Mr. J.M. Yeary be reappointed as a member of the City of Norton Electoral Board for a period of three years.

Mr. Jester advised Council of the discussion he and the Mayor #2739
had had on this date with officials of the highway department regarding
Route 74.

There being no further business to come before council, same adjourned.
