

June 8, 1962

A special meeting called by Mayor Ball to set up the annexation area that was approved by County Board of Supervisors at a joint informal meeting held on June 6th, was held in the Municipal Building on June 8, 1962 at 10:00 A.M. #2179

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, W.R. Hamner, J.C. Holcomb

Absent: Frank Horsman

On motion by W.R. Hamner, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous #2179 roll call vote, council moved that the City Council concurs with the Board of Supervisors that the annexed territory will include a portion of T.M. Godwin land; a portion of the Pepsi Cola Bottling Company land; the L.L. Moore land and a portion of the tract owned by T. N. Gibson; and that the City Council authorizes the engineers to proceed in determining the new descriptions of the property to be annexed as outlined by the County Board of Supervisors and as indicated on Thompson and Litton map dated June, 1962 the title of which is City of Norton, Virginia Existing Land Use Map, the boundaries of the new survey authorized by the council and outlines on this map in green crayon.

On motion by B.E. Ball, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous #2180 roll call vote, council agrees to allow the merchant's association to have a street sale on June 30, 1962, however, the City Council will not assume any liability that be the result from such merchandise being displayed on the sidewalk.

On motion by W.R. Hamner, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous #2181 roll call vote, council authorized the city manager to start repairing sidewalks on Park Avenue as requested and continue as funds are available at the City's expense.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
