

July 3, 1962

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 3, 1962 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, J.C. Holcomb

Absent: W.R. Hamner, F.J. Horsman

Also Present: C.F. Jester, City Manager and R.T. Winston, Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Claude Provence and Mr. D.M. Countiss from 7th Street, N.E. appeared #2201 before council requesting that street in front of their property be repaired; that the ditch line be cleaned out and that a street light be installed. This matter was referred to the City Manager for report back to Council at its next meeting.

Mr. David Ball appeared before council requesting that the hump in the #2202 road in front of his property on Murphy Street be cut down to grade of other part of the street. Referred to city manager for report back to council at next meeting.

Dr. Charles Litton appeared before council regarding the parking problem #2203 in front of his property on Highland Avenue. He requested that a street light be installed in front of his property on Highland Avenue; that the holes in the road be repaired so as to make parking more accessible; consider some method of raising the grade or putting a wall on the left hand side going down Highland.

On motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by B.E. Ball and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council authorized the City Manager to have a street light installed at the above location. The other requests of Dr. Litton were referred to the City Manager for report back to council meeting.

Mr. Jester presented to council the report of the survey made by Mr. Bob #2204 Isaac, President of the Norton Merchant's Association regarding change of parking meters on Park Avenue. Council asked that Mr. Isaac get a more complete survey and report back to next council meeting.

On motion by A.O. Umstead, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by #2205 unanimous roll call vote, council moved the passage of "An Ordinance Authorizing the Issuance of \$400,000 Bonds of the City of Norton to Finance the cost of constructing a sewage disposal system and additional sewer lines, and providing for the submission of the question of issuing said bonds to the qualified voters of said City."

An ordinance regarding licensing of "Outside Agents" was read to council #2206 for the second time. Passage on this ordinance was held over pending Mr. Winston's revision of this ordinance at the request of council.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
