

April 18, 1961

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 18, 1961 at 7:30 P. M. with Vice Mayor A. O. Umstead presiding.

Present: A. O. Umstead, F. W. Glass, W. R. Hamner, J. C. Holcomb
Absent: B. E. Ball

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

On motion by F. W. Glass, seconded by J. C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, Tony C. Slaughter was given permission to transfer his taxi driver's permit to the Pearl Williams Cab Company. #1858

Mr. Hugh Cline, representing Albert Doby, appeared before council regarding taxi driver's permit for Mr. Doby. #1859

After a discussion by Council, James Albert Doby's taxi driver's permit was approved.

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by J. C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, permission was granted Jack Chisenhall and Hershell Boggs to drive a taxicab in the City of Norton. #1860

The taxi driver's application of James Lonnie Smith was held over for further investigation. #1861

Mr. Norton read a letter from the State Water Control Board regarding status of sewage treatment plant for the City of Norton. After a lengthy discussion, council left the tentative date for the referendum in the fall of 1961. #1862

Mr. Norton reported on the progress of the work on Roberts Avenue. #1863

The City Manager advised council that the Clean-up, Fix-up, Paint-up Week would be from May 8th to 19th. This program to be sponsored by the Norton Garden Club and the Green Thumb Garden Club. #1864


A brief discussion of the U. S. Forestry Office moving to Wise was held. #1865
