

August 16, 1960

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Present: B. E. Ball, F. W. Glass, W. R. Hammer, J. C. Holcomb.
Absent: Sol Cury

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. George Wharton appeared before council to request that the city surface treat the two roads leading to his coal mines; one at Round Town and one at East Park Avenue. The City Council agreed to have these roads surface treated. #1717

Mr. W. L. Bartley appeared before council to make inquiry as to whether or not the TV Franchise called for certain boundaries in the City. Council advised Mr. Bartley that the franchise covered the whole city. #1718

Mr. Hershel Bowers appeared before council and expressed his thanks for the help that was given regarding parking in front of his business on 9th Street. He also inquired if the City was going to install parking meters on the other side of the sidewalk. #1719

Mr. Burlie Lioutzi appeared before council requesting permission for issuance of beer license at Liberty Cafe for on-off premises. #1720

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote council authorized the issuance of on-off beer license to Burlie Lioutzi, T/A Liberty Cafe.

Mr. Ball introduced Mr. Lindsey, a councilman from South Norfolk. #1721

Mr. Norton presented a request for water extension outside the corporate limits of the Ramsey section on Alternate Route 58. #1722

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Clarence Holcomb and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was instructed to install this new extension, the cost to be borne by the city and the property owners as per agreement.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned at 8:10 P. M.
