The town council convened in special meeting on the above date at 8:00 P.M. for the purpose of opening bids for the construction of the new municipal building and public health clinic.


The mayor announced the purpose of the meeting and ask all persons who desired to bid on the construction program to submit their bids. It was then ordered that the bids be opened. The following is a tabulation of bids received.
