

September 22, 1953

A special meeting of the town council was held in the Municipal building on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. ^{W.} Ball presiding.

All members of council were present except Fred H. King.

On motion made and duly seconded council unanimously voted to grant permission for the issuance of an on-off premise beer license to Hotel Norton with the provision that the license did not exceed the number permitted to operate in town. #199

On motion made and duly seconded council unanimously granted permission for the issuance on an on-off premise beer and wine license to Frank Bucca, Della Bucca and Irene Blansett, T/A the New York Cafe. #200

On motion made and duly seconded H. L. Amburgy and Ivan Vance were granted permission to operate taxis in the Town of Norton as provided by ordinance. #201

In a general discussion the Town Manager was authorized to proceed with having all plats not properly dedicated brought to councils attention and making agreements with the various owners subject to councils approval for the proper dedication of those plats. #202

The manager was authorized to obtain prices on a grader and tractor mower. #203

Pending further investigation the proposed sidewalk on Spring Avenue was tabled for future discussion. #204

Mr. Kanto, chairman of the School Board presented a request to borrow \$40,000 from the town. #205

On motion made and duly seconded the Town Treasurer and Town Manager were authorized to loan to the Norton School Board a sum not to exceed \$40,000 between September 22, 1953 and Jan. 1, 1954 to be repaid in January of 1954.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
