Upon a motion made and duly seconded the following resolution was adopted #264 by a roll call vote, all members voting AYE.


WHEREAS, the budget for the operation of Wise County for the year ending June 30, 1954, takes care of the services rendered by the County to its citizens including all services in which the City of Norton participates, as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, that part of the funds for said budget derived from local taxation was raised from taxes assessed on all the property in Wise County including that in the City of Norton, and whereas the separation of the finances of Wise County and the finances of Norton, being the change made necessary when Norton became a City of the Second Class, can be better accomplished at the end of the budgetary period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of Wise County concurring, that the budget for Wise County for operation of all the services of Wise County be continued without change until the period covered by same has expired on June 30th, 1954.

That pending the expiration of this budgetary period, no attempt be made to divide the funds on hand as between the Treasurer of Wise County and the Treasurer of Norton and that such division be made after June 30th, 1954, and as of that date.
