The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Building at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.


Mr. J. M. Buchanan appeared before council requesting work be done 11th Street ditch line. #466

Mr. Walker read a letter from Interstate Railroad Company in which they requested refund of taxes paid on their property in the annexed areas. The City Manager was instructed to have the City Attorney check the matter. #467

Mr. King, Chairman of the committee appointed to make an appraisal of damages to Reece and Cohen property as result of building the Viaduct, gave the committee's decision and recommendations. That the City offer to Leonadus Reece \$500.00 damage, build one set of steps on the property line to the top of hill with sidewalk at the head of steps to each porch. Steps will have to be moved on the house on the east to the west end of the porch. For the Cohen property the committee has recommended they offer Cohens \$500.00 damage on the east side of the rear of their property. #468

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by B. E. Ball, the report and recommendations of above committee, as made by Mr. King, was accepted by unanimous roll call vote.
