The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Building on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

James Price presented registration books for council's observation and after a lengthy discussion Council requested that the Electoral Board meet with them to discuss the possibilities of putting Norton into two precincts at the next council meeting. #476

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by unanimous roll call vote, \$315.00 was transferred from Reserve for Contingency to the Election Account. #477

John Leho appeared in behalf of Surplus Foods Committee requesting some assistance in handling the food. #478

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by W. R. Hamner and Carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to pay to the proper authority the sum of \$50.00 per month for a period not to exceed three months to take care of surplus food distribution.


Mr. Leho requested that some work be done on the road leading to his residence and the matter was referred to the City Manager. #479
