

December 16, 1954

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Building at 7:30 P. M. with Vice Mayor Fred H. King presiding.

Present: Fred H. King, A. O. Umstead and Sol Cury.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

George Hunnicutt appeared requesting an easement from the City in the event he should be able to purchase the 12th Street well. #499

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote of those present the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that George Hunnicutt, representing the Pepsi Cola Bottling Company be granted an easement in 12th Street, with proper provision for the protection of the city, to be prepared by the City Attorney and City Manager at such time as requested by Mr. Hunnicutt.

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead, the following resolution was adopted: #500

RESOLVED that G. K. Cantrell be granted an on-off premise A. B. C. License in the City of Norton at the location known as the Norton Restaurant.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Sol Cury and Carried by vote of all those present, the following resolution was adopted: #501

RESOLVED that the City Manager proceed with the preliminary work necessary for the reappraisal of real property in the City of Norton and further that before actual appraising begins that it be submitted to council for approval.
