

January 6, 1955

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Building at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The following list of newly elected officers of the Norton Fire Department was presented: W. C. Necessary, Chief; A. E. Poston, Assistant Chief; Ralph Wilson, Lt.; Paul C. Addison, President; Frank Caruso, Vice President; W. J. Duncan, Jr., Secretary; Henry Yeary, Treasurer; Joe Fischer, Captain.

On a motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred H. King, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the list of newly elected officers of the Fire Department be accepted as read.

On a motion by Fred H. King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the ordinance with reference to the issuance of \$225,000 of bonds for Water Department and \$325,000 of bonds for sewage disposal system be withdrawn until a later date.

The City Manager presented the report of the Chester Engineers.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that the City Manager, Mr. King and Mr. Umstead be authorized to complete the new lighting of streets as discussed and submit additional costs to council.

Mr. Walker presented a taxi application of Odell Greear.

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by W. R. Hamner, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED that after investigation, if found in order, taxi license be granted Odell Greear.

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution was passed:

RESOLVED that the proposed zoning ordinance be placed on second reading and that notice be filed that public hearing be held on January 20th for final adoption.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous vote, the following resolution was adopted:

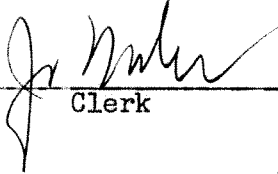
