On a motion by Fred H. King, seconded by A. O. Umstead, the following #575 ordinance regarding delapidated buildings was passed on first reading and public notice of ordinance be given:

BE IT ORDAINED that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to permit any building, structure or additon thereto to exist on property within the City of Norton owned by him or them, which, by reason of delapidation, defect of structure, or other causes, may have become dangerous to life or property or a fire hazard.

Those voting AYE: Messrs. King, Umstead, and Ball. Mr. Hamner not voting.

A brief discussion was held on change in tax collection date. It was decided that the City Attorney and City Manager decide on this matter.

A brief discussion of drainage from garbage dump polluting water system of Polie Hinkle was held. Referred to City Manager. #577

Mr. King brought to council's attention request of Charlie Watlington regarding water running over his property. Referred to City Manager.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
