

June 2, 1955

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Building at 7:30 P. M.

Present: B. E. Ball, Fred H. King, W. R. Hamner and A. O. Umstead

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. E. F. Price appeared before council and discussed the kind and price of registration books for the City of Norton. #580

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to purchase new books for registration according to the recommendations of the Electoral Board.

Mayor Ball appointed a committee of City Attorney, City Manager and Councilman Fred H. King to meet with the Electoral Board to determine just what is needed and report back to council at next regular meeting.

Mr. A. R. Hawkins from Norton Building & Remodeling Firm appeared and discussed the furnishing of the Court Room. #581

On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous vote, it was moved that the Appropriation Ordinance be limited to the reading of the title only. #582

An ordinance making appropriations of sums of money for all necessary expenditures of the City of Norton, Virginia, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955; to prescribe the privisos, terms, conditions and provisions with respect to the items of appropriations and their payment: and to repeal all ordinances wholly in conflict with this ordinance and all ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance to the extent of such inconsistency.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Fred H. King and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the budget for the year 1955-56 was passed. #583

Mr. Walker read request of Paul Bullion for two parking meters in front of his business on Park Avenue. Referred to City Manager. #584

On motion by Fred King, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was authorized to employ an auditing firm to audit the city's books for \$500.00. #585

On motion by Fred King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried unanimously, J. J. Stump was appointed to the School Board for a term of three years, expiring June 30, 1958. #586

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote "An ordinance relating to traffic and regulating the use of public streets in the City of Norton, prescribing regulations relative to the parking of vehicles upon such streets; providing for purchase, leasing, acquiring, installation, operation, maintenance, supervision, regulation and control of the use of Parking Meters and providing for the payment thereof; defining and providing for the establishment of parking meter zones upon the public streets and for an enforcement thereof and providing penalties for the violation thereof" was passed as an emergency ordinance.


On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, an ordinance regarding delapidated buildings was passed.
