

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on the above date at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of the council were present and answered to roll call except Mr. W. R. Hamner.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Richard Baldwin appeared before council asking for an off premise #836 beer license. He presented to council a petition for his selling beer in Ramsey. On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred King and carried by unanimous vote, Richard Baldwin's beer application was tabled for further investigation.

Mr. Fred Mefford appeared before council asking for a water line #837 extension to his property. Matter referred to City Manager.

The City Manager informed council that Mr. Reese's suit against #838 the City was still in court. The City Manager was advised not to do anything more until the suit had been settled.

The City Manager informed council that as yet nothing had been #839 accomplished in the way of a financial settlement with the County.

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by Fred King and carried by unani- #840 mous vote, Silas Leonard's taxi application was tabled until further investigation was made.

On motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by Fred King and carried by #841 a unanimous vote, Roscoe Ely's bid of \$2500 for the Fuller property on 11th Street was rejected.

The City Manager advised council that Mr. J. M. Buchanan wished it #842 brought before council that his property assessment was too high.

The City Manager advised council that he had been advised by the #843 State Water Control Board that the forms on which to apply for federal aid in sewage treatment plant construction would be urnished in the future.

The City Manager advised council that as yet Joe Robinson had not #844 presented a deed to him, therefore, he was not able to proceed with putting in a drain pipe.

Mr. Greear, Mr. Snyder and Mr. Stroh discussed the dam contract #845 with council. Mr. Snyder as yet had been unable to get a bonding company to endorse his bond. Council asked that Messrs. Greear, Snyder and Stroh meet and discuss this matter and report back to council at a later date.

Mr. Ball informed council that TVA wanted to make a flood survey #846 here. The City Manager was instructed to write a letter asking that this be done.

On motion by Fred King, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, in the future all applications for rezoning are to be handled forthwith by the City Manager without reference to the City Council; the City Manager to refer such applications to the Planning Commission for recommendations and then report to the City Council.
