

January 3, 1957

The regular meeting of the City Council was held at 7:30 P. M. on January 3rd in the Municipal Court Room with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous vote, Mr. A. O. Umstead was appointed to serve on the Cumberland's Airport Authority to represent Norton. #954

The City Manager recommended to council that the privilege cards for the Municipal Parking Lot be issued any time on a twelve month or quarterly basis. That a card system be set up as to expiration date and license number of car be noted on check card. That the police department be notified each month if necessary, as to the termination of the permits. Also that a six month card be issued for the sum of \$9.00. Each person having a sticker to be notified one week in advance of their expiration. #955


On motion by Fred H. King, seconded by Sol Cury and carried by Unanimous roll call vote, the recommendations of the City Manager were adopted.


The City Manager advised council of the appointment of Ray Wells as Chief of Police of the City of Norton, effective January 1, 1957. #956
