

June 18, 1957

The regular meeting of the City Council was held on the above date in the Municipal Court Room at 7:30 P. M. with Mayor B. E. Ball presiding.

All members of council except Fred H. King were present and answered to roll call.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. W. H. Seay appeared before council requesting that something be done to eliminate sanitary sewer drainage coming through his property and also to fix the drain which was stopped. Referred to City Manager. #1087

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, W. P. Kanto was reappointed as member of City of Norton School Board for a term of three years, said term to expire June 30, 1960. #1088

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following ordinance was passed: "To provide for the contraction of corporate limits of the City of Norton, Virginia, in pursuance to the Provisions in Article 2, Sections 15-153 thru 15-157 of the Code of Virginia as Heretofore Amended." #1089

On motion by W. R. Hamner, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the following resolution was passed: #1090

Be It Resolved that the City of Norton, Virginia, will participate with the Virginia Department of Highways on a 50-50 basis of the cost of surveying of that section of Alternate Route 58 that lies between its intersection with Kentucky Avenue and its intersection with Park Avenue in the City of Norton, the City's share of the cost to be approximately \$500.00 as estimated by letter, from Mr. W. F. Smith, Urban Engineer, Highway Department of Virginia, dated June 7, 1957.

Be It Further Resolved that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be forwarded to the Virginia Department of Highways.

Mr. W. H. Dawson appeared before council requesting that the dynamiting near his residence on Craig Street be discontinued until such a time that the City has protection for his property from damage done by dynamiting. Matter referred to City Manager. #1091

On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, amendment to Section 33 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Norton was passed on first reading. #1092

Mr. Davis advised council as to status of the City's application to the Housing and Home Finance Agency for sewage disposal and extension loan.


