The City Manager advised council that the N. & W. R. R. Co. would like to modernize their signals at crossings here in Norton. Matter was tabled. #1201


On motion by Sol Cury, seconded by A. O. Umstead and carried by unanimous vote, the slate of officers for the Fire Dept. was approved. #1202


On a motion by A. O. Umstead, seconded by W. R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, the City Manager was instructed to give the employees of the City of Norton a bonus of \$50.00 plus \$2.00 per year for each full year of continuous service over 1 yr. and each employee with service under 1 yr., \$50.00 to be prorated on a basis of a month's work. #1203

Mr. Kanto appeared before council to discuss the new school project. Council assured Mr. W. P. Kanto, Chairman of School Board, that funds would be available when required to take care of addition to the school building, that amount to approximate \$90,000. #1204

The City Manager advised council that he was working on a personnel plan for all the employees of the City of Norton. #1205
