

August 1, 1961

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on August 1, 1961 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor B.E. Ball presiding.

Present: B.E. Ball, A.O. Umstead, W.R. Hammer, J.C. Holcomb, Frank Horsman

Also Present: Mr. C.F. Jester, City Manager and W.T. Bowen, City Attorney

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Fred Mefford, Jr. appeared before council inquiring as to when council #1966 anticipated extending sewer service to the Ramsey section of Norton. Council advised Mr. Mefford that it would be some time before a sewer service would be extended to Ramsey section.

Edna Cochran appeared before council requesting permission for the issuance #196 of an on-off premises beer license for the Norton Restaurant.

On motion by Frank Horsman, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that Edna Cochran be granted an on-off premise beer license T/A Norton Restuarant.

Ruby Leho appeared before council asking that something be done regarding #196 fixing of road to Roberts Avenue. Referred to City Manager.

The City Manager presented a report on the Fire Prevention Program for #1969 Norton. After a lengthy discussion and upon motion by J.C. Holcomb, seconded by A.O. Umstead and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the City Manager be allowed to follow his recommendations as outlined in his report.

The City Manager presented a Proposed Sick Leave Plan for City Employees. #1970 On motion by A.O. Umstead, seconded by W.R. Hamner and carried by unanimous roll call vote, council moved that the Sick Leave Plan for City Employees be adopted as written by the City Manager.

The City Manager presented a request of Mrs. Roy Wells on Kentucky Avenue #1971 for the installation of a street light near the addition to the High School Building.

On motion by Frank Horsman, seconded by J.C. Holcomb and carried by unanimous vote, council moved that a light be installed on Kentucky Avenue near the addition to the High School Building.

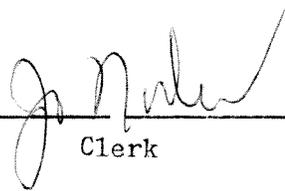
George Hunnicutt appeared before council suggesting that the City annex #1972 certain properties in the Bear Creek section for Industrial purposes.

The Mayor appointed the following committee, Frank Horsman, Frank Jester, George Hunnicutt and W.T. Bowen, City Attorney, to look into this matter of the possibility of annexing some land as discussed by Mr. Hunnicutt.

Mr. J.B. Taggart, chairman of committee delegated to make a study of the #1973 possibility of different power companies coming into this section with their service presented and read in full a report of their findings.

Council expressed their thanks to this committee and asked that they continue on with their findings. Mr. Cury, a member of this committee, asked that a reasonable reimbursement of expenditures be given this committee for expense in the future.

There being no further business before the council same adjourned.
