

An organizational meeting was held at 8:30 a.m. Monday, July 2, 1990 in Council Chambers with City Manager E. W. Ward presiding.

Absent: Kenneth Asbury, City Attorney

Also Present: E. W. Ward, City Manager

City Manager Ward opened the floor for nominations for Mayor for a two year term.

William Mays nominated Mr. Robert Raines.

Upon a motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by Ron McCall, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mr. Ward declared Mr. Raines Mayor of the City of Norton and after being sworn in by the City Clerk, Mayor Raines took over the meeting.

The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for Vice Mayor of the City of Norton.

Jack Wallace nominated William Mays.

Upon a motion by Ron McCall, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared William Mays the Vice Mayor of the City of Norton and he was sworn in by the City Clerk.

The other members of Council took their seats and Mayor Raines welcomed the new members.

The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for City Manager.

Jack Wallace nominated Mr. E. W. Ward.

Upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Ron McCall, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared E. W. Ward reappointed as City Manager.

The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for City Attorney. William Mays nominated Kenneth Asbury.

Upon a motion by Ron McCall, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared Kenneth Asbury reappointed as City Attorney.

The Mayor opened the floor for nominations for City Clerk.

Jack Wallace nominated Mary Brown.

Upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Linda Sturgill, and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared Mary Brown reappointed as City Clerk.

Council discussed the meeting dates and time of Council meetings and were in concurrence to keep the same schedule as in the past - the first and third Tuesdays of each month at 7:30 p.m.

Council had been presented with A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Dispensing with Second Reading of Ordinances.

The City Manager advised this was merely a housekeeping item that had been passed previously.

Councilwoman Sturgill questioned the use of the word "heretofore" in this

Following a brief discussion and upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by the following vote: Ayes - Wallace, Raines, Mays, and McCall. Nays - Sturgill, Council adopted A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Dispensing with Second Reading of Ordinances with the condition that the word "heretofore" be verified with the City Attorney.
