

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Norton City Council was held on Tuesday, August 1, 2000 at the Municipal Council Chambers at 7:30 p.m. with Vice Mayor William Mays presiding.

The invocation was given by Father Joseph Facura and was followed by the pledge which was led by City Treasurer Joseph Stallard.

Upon a motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by Joseph Fawbush, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to adopt the minutes of the July 18, 2000 meeting as presented.

There was no response to the Vice Mayor's call for visitors.

The City Treasurer, Mr. Joe Stallard, was present to give Council his annual report. He briefly went over the information he had supplied Council in their packets and advised he was willing to answer any questions.

Mr. Ward briefly gave Council an update on the 2000 annual Virginia Municipal League Conference which will be held in Arlington County October 22-24, 2000. He advised the City has a block of rooms reserved and asked that Council members advise him if they can or cannot attend.

Upon a motion by Joseph Fawbush, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to approve a check made payable to the Norton City Schools in the amount of \$155, 000.

There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting adjourned for Council to go into a work session to discuss the Comprehensive Water Study.


