

The regular meeting of the Norton City Council was held in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building on Tuesday, July 5, 1994 at 7:30 p.m. with Mayor Raines presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Jack Wallace, Robert Raines, William Mays, and Ron McCall

Also Present: E. W. Ward, City Manager and Joe Pippin, City Attorney

The invocation was given by Father Tom Collins which was followed by the pledge led by the Assistant City Manager, Fred Ramey.

Upon a motion by Ron McCall, seconded by William Mays, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to adopt the minutes of the June 21, 1994 meeting as presented.

At this time, Mayor Raines amended the agenda to include under Item 7B, Executive Session, Actual or Probable Litigation as per 2.1-344(A) (7) of the Code of Virginia as amended, Acquisition of Real Property for Public Purpose as per 2.1-344(A) (3) of the Code of Virginia as amended, and add Item #6 -Salary of the City Manager.

There was no response to the Mayor's call for visitors.

A public hearing was held on An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Adopting Conditional Zoning for the Municipality.

Mr. Ward advised this ordinance had been duly advertised.

There were no comments or questions prior to the opening of the public hearing.

Mayor Raines opened the public hearing.

There were no public comments.

Following a discussion and upon a motion by Ron McCall, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by the following vote: Roberts, Mays, McCall, Raines YES, Wallace - NO, Council moved to adopt An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Adopting Conditional Zoning for the Municipality. Council had been presented in their packets a copy of a check in the amount of \$230,000 made payable to the Norton City Schools dated June 29, 1994.

Upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to approve a check in the amount of \$230,000 made payable to the Norton City Schools dated June 29, 1994.

Upon a motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel as per 2.1-344(A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, as amended, Actual or Probable Litigation as per 2.1-344(A) (7) of the Code of Virginia, as amended, the Acquisition of Real Property for Public Purpose as per 2.1-344(A) (3) of the Code of Virginia, as amended, and Salary of the City Manager.

Mayor Raines declared the meeting in Executive Session.

Upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Ron McCall, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to go back in regular session.

Mayor Raines declared the meeting back in regular session.

The Clerk then polled each member of Council as to the Certification of Executive Meeting with each answering aye. The Clerk then read the entire Resolution of the Certification of Executive Meeting. Upon a motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved to adopt A Resolution of the Certification of Executive Meeting. (Insert)

Mayor Raines advised that there was no appointment to be made to the position of Mr. Byron Cantrell on the Norton Industrial Development Authority.

Mayor Raines opened the floor for nominations to the unexpired term of Mr. Dennis Willis on the Norton Industrial Development Authority which will expire on May 10, 1996.

Ron McCall nominated Mr. William J. Sturgill.

Upon a motion by William Mays, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared Mr. William J. Sturgill appointed to fill the unexpired term of Mr. Dennis Willis on the Norton Industrial Development Authority. Said term will expire on May 10, 1996.

Mayor Raines opened the floor for nominations of a Business Representative to the Private Industry Council for a three year term which will expire on June 30, 1997.

Jack Wallace nominated that Mr. Don Green be reappointed to the Council.

Upon a motion by Ron McCall, seconded by Roy Roberts, and passed by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations cease.

Mayor Raines declared Mr. Don Green reappointed as a Business Representative to the Private Industry Council for a three year term which will expire on June 30, 1997.

There was no action taken on the appointment to the City of Norton Planning Commission or the Junction Center for Independent Living.

As to the Salary of the City Manager, upon a motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by William Mays, and passed by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved to reappropriate a 7.2% increase to the existing salary of Mr. Ward.

There were no comments from the City Manager.

16068

In comments from Council, Mr. Mays complimented both the Centennial Committee and the City for the Fourth of July activities in the City. He stated it was one of the best he had seen and that the fireworks were great.

Mr. Roberts advised he had been approached as to the need to have a City Flag. Mr. Ward had advised him that we already have a logo. Mr. Ward stated he would be glad to pursue this.


There being no further business to come before the Council, the meeting adjourned.
