

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Council Chambers on February 3, 1987 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Daniels presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Robert Raines, Cliff Daniels, Milas Franks, William Mays

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager

Invocation was given by Councilman Raines, followed with Pledge of Allegiance
led by Chief Mongle. 13715

The Mayor announced there would be two amendments to the agenda - one in Item 6
New Business - 6-C will be added for approval of check over \$100,000.00 - Item B
an executive session for legal matters. 13716

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous
vote, Council moved that minutes of January 20, 1987 be approved as presented. 13717

The Mayor announced there was a slight modification of agenda before audience
for visitors.

I would like to ask Miss Nosler to come forward. Mayor Daniels presented
Miss Nosler with a Plaque of Appreciation for her fifty (50) Years of service to
the City of Norton. He also said "good things come in small packages" - He presented
her a gift of cultured pearl earrings. 13718

Vice Mayor Franks presented Miss Nosler a paper on how things were in 1937.

Mayor announced we would now have first public hearing - "An Ordinance Granting
the Century Virginia Corporation, Grantee of Park Avenue, Norton, County of Wise,
State of Virginia, Hereinafter referred to as "Grantee", a Non-Exclusive Franchise
in the City of Norton, and providing for the regulation of such activity". Clyde
Abee and John Taylor, Representatives of Century-Cable TV were present., with
Clyde Abee addressing the subject and answering questions of the audience during
the public hearing. 13719

One of the questions from audience was in regard to taking off N.B.C. Station
of Huntington and putting the third C.B.S. Station on.

Vice Mayor Franks ask Mr. Abee to summarize the changes proposed to be made
in franchise. - On Page 2, Par. 5, first line the word "can" instead of "shall";
Page 6, Par. 3, "Make Available" instead of "provide"; Page 7, Par. 1 "May declare
forfeiture of same, etc."

Council discussed this matter at length - In absence of Mr. Asbury, City Attorney,
Council did not take any action on this franchise at this time - The Mayor declared
Public Hearing closed. (See 13727)

Next Public Hearing - "An Ordinance of the City Council of City of Norton,
Virginia, designating the Director of Social Services of the City of Norton, Virginia
as the Local Board of Social Services, and establishing an Advisory Board to such
Officer with Respect to the Duties and Functions imposed upon him or her by this Title."

The City Manager addressed this subject as to need for this change.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous
vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia,
Designating the Director of Social Services of the City of Norton, Virginia as the Local
Board of Social Services, and Establishing an Advisory Board to Such Officer with Respect
to the Duties and Functions imposed upon him or her by this Title" be passed on
first reading. 13720

Public Hearing on "An Ordinance Amending and Reenacting Section 22-1, 22-13, 22-15,
and 22-18 of the "Zoning Ordinance of the City of Norton, Virginia, to Provide for
the Establishment of Regulations for Land Subject to Flood." 13721

Richard Hurt, City Building Inspector, addressed this subject, pointing out
all changes that needed to be made by City Ordinance. He spoke on Trailer Parks

under this Flood Plain Zoning Ordinance - He briefed council on the effect of this ordinance both pros and cons.

Mr. E.C. Mullins and Donnie Fulkds, owners of Trailer Courts also spoke on this subject.

Mr. Hurt advised council that this proposed ordinance was in keeping with the State Regulations. After a lengthy discussion by council and audience - Mayor Daniels summarized questions to be considered and advised he thought it best to wait until Attorney was present to take action.

The next Public Hearing is "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia Amending and Reenacting Section 2-1 Section 19 and Section 2-4 Section 19-7 of the Subdivision Ordinance of the City of Norton, Virginia Amendments Adopted May 17, 1983 to Provide for the Establishment of Regulations of Land Subject to Flooding." Mr. Brown and Mr. Hurt addressed this subject. Mr. Hurt advised of the State's willingness to help out in this ordinance. Mayor advised action would be delayed until attorney gets here. 13722

On motion by Robert Raines, seconded by William Mays and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to table the two flood Plain Ordinances until next council meeting. 13723

The next Public Hearing is "An Ordinance Taking Official Action on the Enforcement of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code, Volume II, Building Maintenance Code, Assigning Inspection to the Building Inspector and Designating an Appeals Board.

Mr. Hurt Addressed this subject, advising the State had advised the City would have to adopt their ordinance or have none at all. A brief discussion followed. 13724

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance Taking Official Action on the Enforcement of the Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code, Volume II, Building Maintenance Code, Assigning inspection to the Building Inspector and Designating an Appeals Board" be passed on first reading.

A "Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, Appointing a Director of Social Services, and Appointing an Advisory Board of five Members to serve in an Advisory Capacity to the Director of Social Services with respect to the Duties and Functions imposed upon Him by Law."

Mr. Brown addressed this subject. Council briefly discussed this matter. 13725

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by William Mays and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "A Resolution of City of Norton, Virginia Appointing a Director of Social Services, and Appointing an Advisory Board of Five Members to serve in an Advisory Capacity to the Director of Social Services with Respect to the Duties and Functions imposed upon him by Law" be passed.

Request for this agreement made and Entered into on this the 19th day of January, 1987 By and Between the City of Norton, Virginia, a Municipal Corporation, Norton, Virginia, herein called the "Licensor", and B.A. Mullican Lumber and Manufacturing Company, a Tennessee Corporation, Appalachia, Virginia, herein called the "Licensee". Mt. Brown addressed this subject at length with Council. Mr. Scott Porter of Mullican Lumber Co. was present and discussed this matter with Council. Joe Tom Howard also spoke in behalf of this agreement - Vice Mayor Franks and Councilman Roberts also spoke on this matter. A lengthy discussion followed. 13726


On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Robert Raines and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that this matter be tabled and placed on Agenda for February 17th.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by William Mays and carried by the following roll call votes, Raines, Daniels, Franks, Mays, YES; Roberts, Abstained, Council moved that an "Ordinance Granting to Century-Virginia Corporation, Grantee, of Park Avenue, City of Norton, County of Wise, State of Virginia, Hereinafter Referred to as "Grantee", a Non-Exclusive Franchise in the City of Norton, and providing for the Regulation of such Activity; Article II, Term to be specified for 15 years", be passed on 1st reading. 13727


