

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Council Chambers on July 7, 1987 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Daniels presiding.

Invocation was given by Rev. Parrish Jones, followed with Pledge of Allegiance led by Kenneth Asbury. 13861

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, minutes of June 16, 1987 meeting were approved as presented. 13862

There was no response to the Mayor's call for visitors. 13863

Confirmation of a check, in the amount of \$200,000.00, to the Norton City Schools. On motion by Jack Wallace, seconded by William Mays and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council confirmed a check in the amount of \$200,000.00 to City of Norton School Fund. 13864

A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, Confirming That Volunteer Firefighters Regularly Enrolled in the Norton Fire Department are Recognized as Employees for Benefits Under the Virginia Workers Compensation Act.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by William Mays and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that a "Resolution of the City Council of the City of Norton, Virginia, Confirming that Volunteer Firefighters Regularly Enrolled in the Norton Fire Department are Recognized as Employees for Benefits Under the Virginia Workers Compensation Act." be passed. Discussion of Water Reserves. Mr. Brown addressed this subject. He advised that at the time the agenda was made he was concerned about the water but that the rains over the weekend had helped the situation. He stated that as of July 7th at 8:45 A.M. there was 113.8 million gallons of water. At the present time there was no need for real concern. 13866

Mr. Brown presented a letter from the Department of Waste Management asking that they be advised by July 10th if the City of Norton would like their own Emergency Commission or to join in with county if they would concur. Mr. Brown will advise council at the July 21st meeting the decision of the county. 13867

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go into executive session to discuss Personnel Matters as Per 2-1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia, as Amended and Legal Matters as Per. 2-1-344 (A) (6) of the Code of Virginia, as Amended. 13868

On motion by William Mays, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session. 13869

The Mayor reported there were no comments regarding Legal Matters.

The Mayor advised that appointments to Airport Commission, Redevelopment & Housing Authority and Planning Commission would be tabled until next council meeting. 13870

Mayor Daniels Announced that next thing on Agenda was appointment to Coal and Gas Road Improvement Advisory Committee.

Roy Roberts nominated Cliff Daniels as a member of the Coal & Gas Improvement Advisory Committee.

On motion by William Mays, seconded by Jack Wallace and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that the nominations be closed.

The Mayor is now a member of the Coal & Gas Road Improvement Advisory Committee.

Mayor Daniels commended Charlie Brown, City Manager and his staff for the fine Fireworks Exhibition.
