

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on March 19, 1985 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: Roy Roberts, Ray Salyers, George Hunnicutt, Milas Franks, Cliff Daniels

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

Invocation was given by Father Joseph D'Aurora

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of March 5, 1985 be approved as presented. 13124

"An Ordinance Establishing Standards of Conduct of Officers and Employees on the Subject of Conflict of Interest."

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance Establishing Standards of Conduct of Officers and Employees on the Subject of Conflict of Interest" be passed on second reading. 13125

Request by the School to Apply for a Literary Loan to cover the Cost of Asbestos Removal in Both School Buildings.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that authorize City of Norton School Board to make application for Literary Loan in the amount of \$170,000.00 as per resolution. 13126

Request for Approval, and Authorization for the City Manager to Sign, a Municipal Compliance Plan for the City of Norton and the Town of Wise, Council briefly discussed this matter.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to sign a Municipal Compliance Plan for the City of Norton and Town of Wise subject to the City Attorney Approval of the exception of the County of Wise at the present time as a party to this application, subject to the reauthorization by Town of Wise naming the City of Norton as the lead agency and hence express the implicity of authorizing Mr. Brown to sign on their behalf. 13127

A Resolution of Support to the Regional Concept of Primary Road Improvements.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved the adoption of Resolution of Support to the Regional Concept of Primary Road Improvements", and that the Mayor be the City's representative at the meeting. 13128

Mayor Hunnicutt advised council that while on the subject of roads, he thought it a good idea for another resolution regarding Coal Haul Road Tax. The Mayor discussed this matter at length with Council, bringing them up-to-date on the history of these roads. Council instructed the City Manager to get facts together on this matter, such as number of residents living on East and West side of Route 610, costs, etc. of these highways, and bring back to council for them to decide what they can do on this matter. 13129

A "Resolution Declaring Calendar Year 1985 as the Year of the Teacher in Norton.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "A resolution Declaring Calendar Year 1985 as the Year of the Teacher in Norton" be passed. 13130

Request for Funds from Contingency, in the amount of \$2,727.30 for services billed that were not in the Budget.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to take from 13131

contingency the sum of \$2727.30 to be set up in a separate cost accounting.

Request for a letter of commitment, in the amount of \$23,616.00, as the City of Norton's Portion to Expand Existing Regional Office Space, the Mailbox Library Storage Space and Stack Space.

Mrs. Bruce Fraley presented Architect sketches of the proposal and explained this subject to some length. Mrs. Fraley advised that the final plans must be in Richmond by 5:00 P.M. on April 1st.

Council discussed this matter at length with members of Library Committee present.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that issue a letter of intent to support City of Norton's portion to expand existing regional office space, the Mailboard Library Storage Space and Stack Space.

Councilman Salyers inquired as to what could be done toward having alarm systems cut off after the alarm had been taken care of. He stated the Policemen were having a time answering all the alarms. Matter referred to City Manager under directives of the City Attorney.


Comments by the City Manager.


