

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on July 17, 1984 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Invocation was given by Rev. Spencer Price.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of July 3, 1984 be approved as presented. 11301

The Mayor announced it was time for public hearing on "An Ordinance Amending and Reordaining Chapter 12 of the Norton City Code, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Stopping, Standing and Parking. Matter discussed briefly.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that amend paragraph g of the ordinance to read \$25.00 in lieu of \$10.00 as written. 11302

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that "An Ordinance Amending and Reordaining Chapter 12 of the Norton City Code, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Stopping, Standing, and Parking be passed on seconded reading as amended. 11303

Review and Approval of a new deed for Norton Heights, A Virginia Limited Partnership.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by the following votes, Franks, Hunnicutt, Salyers, YES; Roberts, abstained, Council moved approve the deed of property as stated by the City Attorney to Norton Heights, A Virginia Limited Partnership, P.O. Box 668, Norton, Va. with the correction and recommendation of the City Attorney. 11304

Presentation by Dewberry & Davis relative to progress in the Norton water study project.

Mr. Bobby Lane addressed the subject by stating that first they wanted to bring council uptodate on status of Hydraulic analysis of your system and go over some recommendations that we have with reference to the analysis. Secondly to speak with you about a source of funding for improvements and make recommendations as far as an application for a portion of the funding for the project. The C.D.B.G. applications to the Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development are due on August 3rd. Therefore, we wanted to make this presentation for your consideration before that time.

Mr. Steve Hively presented the Hydraulic Analysis. He pointed out areas where they had discovered most of the trouble in water system. 11305

Mr. Lane addressed the subject of the C.D.B.G. application. Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Lane. Council was in agreement that if they made application for this \$577,000 they reserved the right to accept or decline this application if it is approved. The Mayor stated to representatives that in his opinion they had exceeded their original commission to work with the City of Norton.

Resolution authorizing the City Manager to apply for a Virginia Community Development Block Grant.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that "Resolution Authorizing Submittal of a Community Development Block Grant Application in the amount of \$577,000.00 with the stipulation that council has the right to accept or decline grant if approved be passed. 11306

Request to carry forward \$35,816.64 in encumbrances from fiscal year 1983-84 to fiscal year 1984-85.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by the following roll call votes: Hunnicutt, Roberts, Salyers, YES; Franks, Abstained, Council moved that the City Manager be authorized to carry forward \$35,816.64 in encumbrances from fiscal year 1983-84 to fiscal year 1984-85.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Milas Franks and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that they go into executive session to discuss legal matters as Per 2.1-344 (A) (6) and Personnel as Per 2.1-344 (A) (1) of the Code of Virginia as amended.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved they go back into regular session.

The Mayor declared council back in regular session.

The Mayor stated, sorry to report that executive session was fruitless. Failed to appoint anybody to Planning Commission. In reference to Norton Redevelopment & Housing Authority appointment - holding in abeyance.

Comments by the City Manager - Mr. Ewing and myself have met to get the map prepared from Thomposon & Litton on the water line area that is anticipated and draft will be completed in two weeks.

To answer the question of Councilman Roberts regarding TV - I have talked with Mr. Taylor of the Cable Company and he advises that ESPN station will be on by July 20th and not later than July 25th - this will be on Channel 6.

Councilman Franks ask the City Manager if anything could be done about the traffic lights at the intersections of side streets. The manager advised they had taken this up with the Bristol office and a representative would be over next week to see what could be done with the matter.
