On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by the following votes: Roberts, Salyers, Hunnicutt, Daniels, YES; Franks, No; Council moved 13377 that grant permit with two waivers, filing fee and audit fee.

Request to change date of next council meeting due to the election.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved to change meeting date of next council meeting to Wednesday November 7, 1984.

Approval of transition Plan for the City of Norton to comply with Federal Revenue Sharing Regulations.

On motion by Milas Franks, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that accept the transition plan to comply with Federal Revenue Sharing Regulations as presented by City Manager and to proceed post haste on the matter.

In regard to other personnel - preliminary discussion of the four engineers will be interviewed by the administration and final decision will be made by the council.

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by Ray Salyers and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that authorize and direct City Manager to proceed 13381 with interviews with engineers for water works as covered in the ad and bring back to Council.
