

The regular meeting of the City Council was held in the Municipal Court Room on April 19, 1983 at 7:30 P.M. with Mayor Hunnicutt presiding.

Present: George Hunnicutt, W.F. McElroy, Cliff Daniels, Vic Jones, Roy Roberts

Also Present: C.R. Brown, City Manager & Kenneth Asbury, Attorney

On motion by Roy Roberts, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of April 5, 1983 be approved as presented. 10827

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that minutes of April 18th be approved as presented. 10828

Mr. Sam Pickering appeared before Council requesting the street on Virginia Avenue between 9th & 10th Streets be blocked off on May 6th & 7th for auction of Mrs. N.H. Short's Estate, the time to be from 10:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. on both days. This matter referred to City Manager for action. 10829

Anne Massey in keeping with "Keep America Beautiful Week" presented David Lawson, the winner of LOGO contest the prize as sponsored by the Norton Clean & Beautiful Commission. 10830

Mayor Hunnicutt announced it was time for Public Hearing to "Increase Revenue Sharing Funds for Entitlement Period 13 and a Proposed Use of These Funds".

The City Manager read the Proposed amendment to Revenue Sharing Budget, Entitlement Period 13. Items to be considered: Salt Spreader, Police Cars, Rebuild 1978 Pak-Mor R225, Compliance Audit, Light Duty Pick-Up, Pool Repairs. Council discussed this proposed amendment at length. 10831

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by the following roll call votes: Hunnicutt, McElroy, Daniels, Roberts, YES; Jones, NO, Council moved that "Proposed Amendment to Revenue Sharing Budget Entitlement Period 13 be passed with the stipulation that each of the six items will be brought back to council for approval.

Councilman Roberts inquired as to possibility of usage-lease vehicles for police department. The City Manager was directed to check into this matter.

The City Manager inquired as to whether or not he could go ahead and order the police cars.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that City Manager be authorized to purchase two police cars with two old police cars to be retired, funds from Revenue Sharing. 10832

Mr. Brown advised he had received bid on Pak-Mor in the amount of \$5,390.00.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that rebuild 1978 Pak-Mor for \$5,390.00 as submitted by Pak-Mor. Funds from Revenue Sharing Entitlement 13. 10833

Request by the City Manager to demolish the Jackson House located at 133 Main Avenue, S.W. The City Council discussed this matter at length with Mr. Brown. They agreed to carry this matter over until next council meeting for action. 10834

Vic Jones nominated Bill Clements and Wally Witt for reappointment to Norton Industrial Development Authority.

W.F. McElroy moved, seconded by Cliff Daniels and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed. 10835

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Bill Clements and Wally Witt reappointed to Norton Industrial Development Authority for four year period, said period to expire 5-10-87.

Councilman Daniels brought out that in past nominations have been considered in executive session.

Request of Board of Public Welfare to reappoint Beulah Hawk and Keith Burchette for four year term, said term to expire 5-22-87.

Cliff Daniels nominated Beulah Hawk & Keith Burchette to be reappointed to Board of Public Welfare for four year term, said term to expire 5-22-87. 10836

On motion by Vic Jones, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that nominations be closed.

Mayor Hunnicutt declared Beulah Hawk and Keith Burchette reappointed to Board of Public Welfare for four year term, said term to expire May 22, 1987.

Appointment to the Policy Board of the Job Training Partnership Act for the Service Delivery Area of Planning Districts One and Two. Council briefly discussed this matter.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by Vic Jones and carried by unanimous vote, Council moved that appointment be carried over until May 3, 1983 meeting with Mr. Brown acting until appointment is made. 10837

Request by the Board of Public Welfare for a Budget Adjustment in this Fiscal Year, such funds to come from the unappropriated Welfare Reserve. Council discussed this matter briefly.

On motion by Cliff Daniels, seconded by W.F. McElroy and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that authorize budget adjustment of \$1700.00 to Department of Social Services to come from unappropriated reserve. 10838

Selection of auditor for City of Norton for next three fiscal audits.

On motion by W.F. McElroy, seconded by Roy Roberts and carried by unanimous roll call vote, Council moved that accept Firm of Thrower & Thrower as Auditors, as outlined in Mr. Brown's request for a three year period. 10839

Comments by City Manager - Request from Little League to provide help on improving the field located on City property. City forces are willing to donate their time with use of City equipment. Council was in agreement for this to be done. 10840

The City Manager advised that on Friday at 11:00 A.M. we will have representatives from different schools and colleges in which we may choose two individuals for your consideration of one individual to serve on education part of the Partnership Job Training Program. This will be brought to you on May 3rd. 10841


The City Manager advised council of public hearing to be held at 7:00 P.M. on April 28th regarding beer & wine sales on Sunday. 10842


Council set first work session on budget for April 26th at 7:00 P.M. 10843
